Oril Lee Hunn (Lee) passed away in Chico, Monday, March 6 due to Alzheimer's complications. He was 86 years old. Lee was born March 10, 1936, in Hobert Oklahoma to Bill Hunn and Mattie Hunn. As a very young child Mattie, Bill, and Lee travel to California looking for work, they found work as farm laborers in the Central Valley. Lee spent time in the fields with his parents.
