ALBERT EDWARD REDAMONTI OF LOS MOLINOS, CA, PASSED AWAY IN LOS MOLINOS ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 2022.

Albert Redamonti passed away peacefully on November 16, 2022, at his home in Los Molinos. Albert was born on September 18, 1931. He attended grammar school in Vina and high school in Los Molinos and then served two years during the Korean Conflict, stationed in Okinawa.

Albert attended Chico State University on the GI bill where he met his future wife, Ailene (Traynor). They married on November 23, 1957. Albert worked on highway construction in Northern California, Oregon, and Washington State. He worked on the construction of the Third Power Plant on the Grand Coulee Dam for six years before being severely injured. After his recovery, he decided to come back to his home and take over the family farm along with his brother, Walter. Albert loved farming, but having grown up on a dairy, he said he never wanted to see the "back end" of another cow and decided to plant orchards instead.

Albert and Ailene were married for nearly 65 years (just one week shy of their 65th wedding anniversary). They raised three children, Ed Redamonti, Colleen

Redamonti-Skover and Andrea Redamonti-Campos. Albert and Ailene became grandparents to Hannah, Rachel, Anthony, Eva, Diego, and Luca.

Albert was also an avid outdoorsman and he loved hunting and fishing throughout his life. He enjoyed annual fishing trips to Eagle Lake and occasional hunting excursions to Idaho and Colorado, all with various family members and friends.

Albert's parents, Mary and Albert Sr., immigrated from Switzerland and came to Los Molinos in 1927.

Albert is survived by his wife Ailene, son Ed (Lisa), daughter Colleen (Jeff), daughter Andrea (German), sisters Mary Coad, Toni Grandaw, and Frances Sha, and several nieces and nephews.

Albert will best be remembered for his love of farming and devotion to his family.

A Celebration of Life is planned for Sunday, December 11th at 1:00 pm at the Los Molinos Veterans Hall.
