Clarence "Dale" Driggers, 89, of Gerber, Ca, passed away Wednesday, March 7, 2018

at his home with his wife at his side. He had struggled with heart disease for 5 years.

He was born in Altos, OK, September 27, 1928, to James and Amanda Driggers.

Dale was a godly, loving, humble gentleman. He loved his wife of 65 years; some said he

treated her like a queen. If she had even mentioned she would like to have the "moon" he

would have been found trying to get it for her. His children had him wrapped around

their little fingers but he always had good guidelines and boundaries.

Music was a big part of Dale's family's lives from early childhood. He played the tuba in high school. The guitar was his specialty in church but for church hay rides and outings he chose his harmonica. He also played the mandolin and other instruments.

Dale graduated from Loyalton, Ca High School in 1948, then joined the US Navy for 4 years.

In 1952 he met the love of his life and had a double wedding with Ina's brother Arlin and his wife Francis in 1953.

He worked in the saw mill in Loyalton, CA for 9 years. In 1962 Dale moved his family to Sacramento, CA where he worked for McClellan Air Force Base for 16 years as an electronics technician. During this time Dale returned to college to earn his AA from American River College. He was a lifelong learner.

Dale and his wife Ina moved to Gerber CA where he resided until his death. Together they co-pastored the home fellowship Faith Hope Love Ministries from 1988 – to present.
