As a child, she attended Berrendos Middle School, and then Los Molinos and Red Bluff High Schools. Cindy married her husband, Martin Dale Hoofard, on September 14th, 1974. Cindy and Martin had their first child, Rebecca Lynn, in February of 1976, and then a son, Dale Royce, in August of 1977.

As a young adult, Cindy worked as a mill worker and also a baker for the local Raley's grocery store. She was later employed as a bookkeeper, tax preparer, and customer service employee for Blue Shield of California. Cindy never knew a stranger. She couldn't go anywhere without being stopped by someone who loved & cared for her, or by someone whose life had touched. Cynthia became a Christian in 1999.
