David William Lisk 73, of Litchfield, Ca passed away March 9, 2023, in Corning, Ca after a heroic battle with cancer. David was born in Salinas, Ca, on November 22, 1949, to Stan and Anne Lisk. He attended Sacred Heart Elementary School and Palma Jr and Senior High Schools.
