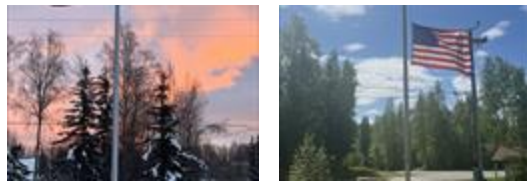

*It's not for me to hang this flag in a case on the wall, but to let it fly and share with all who pass by. The freedoms we enjoy today is because of people like Uncle Gene Brown WWII United States Merchant Marine, My Grandfather Clarence Brown WWI US Marines, Uncle Bill Brown WWII US Navy, my dad George Kaufmann WWII US Navy, and the rest of the Americans from that generation. They volunteered by the millions, to defend the*

*Freedoms that we cherish today because of what this flag stands for. What would this world be like if this flag did not fly...*

*Uncle Gene was the last of the Browns, and with his passing the Brown name also passed away from our family tree. It's a proud name, and it's a good name, it will be remembered, it will be missed.*

*On this day, we Kaufmann's (Ken, Karl, Kris and I) raise this flag in homage to the Brown's, an All American Family.*
