Joseph 'Joe' B. Klug (Daddy) passed away on April 16, 2022, at the age of 88.

Joe was born into this

world on April 26, 1933, to his parents, Joseph Louis Klug and Mary Felicia Klug (Zetmeir). Though he was

born in Arkansas, he was raised in Oklahoma, where he grew to love and appreciate the outdoors.

Joe lived most of his adult life in Capay California, where on a small 5-acre plot he and his then wife,

Barbara raised four daughters; Lauri, Beth, Amy, and Sara.

Joe was a hardworking father, hauling hay for various ranches from Tehama and Glenn counties to

McArthur, Fall River, and Bieber. He also worked in the agriculture industry, hauling loads of sugar

beets, almonds, and prunes throughout the valley. He loved these communities, for their simple but

beautiful landscapes and cherished friendships he made. Joe was also a beekeeper and raised and

managed over 100 beehives at times. Although the bee stings were too numerous to count and the

constant feeding of sugar syrup exhausting and costly, watching the bees work and listening to the hum

in the air made it all worth it for our dad.

Joe was an amazing artist, and his true love was western art. He also enjoyed Native American art, and all things country western including horses, cowboys, wide-open spaces, billowing clouds, and desert rock formations. Joe was a simple man with simple pleasures, like the pink and blue color of the sky at dusk and the tranquility of his Capay home in the evening hours. Joe is survived by his four daughters; Lauri, Beth, Amy, and Sara, ten grandchildren; Danielle, Brittany, Brenden, Michael, Jamie, Josiah, Jeremiah, Jada, Ashley, Kayla, and ten great-grandchildren. Joe will be dearly missed, especially by his daughters. They have fond memories of arrowhead hunting, picnic barbeques, gold panning, and many outdoor excursions. He was a kind, gentle, and loving father who was fair and consistent and committed to staying in his daughter's lives.
