Sunday, August 11, following a 1 ½ year battle with cancer.

Kathy was born in Red Bluff, CA on June 21, 1963, to Jessey and Rose Mary Keathley. Kathy grew up in Red Bluff except for a few years in El Camino and Anderson, CA. She attended Red Bluff High School.

After graduation, she attended Butte College and then completed her Associates

Degree through Shasta College sometime later.

After meeting Douglas Hausman, they married on August 4, 1984. They just celebrated their 40th wedding anniversary.

For 37 years, Kathy was in administration for both the Sheriffs and Police Dept in

Red Bluff. Kathy's dedication was like no other. She was the most caring, kindest,

giving, and selfless person anyone has ever known. She loved her family and friends unconditionally and she loved the Lord.

Kathy's greatest joy is her son, Dylan. Kathy beamed with pride when she swore

Dylan in as a police officer for the Red Bluff Police Dept on June 12, 2023.

Kathy's passion in life was photography, scrapbooking, crafting, and giving homemade gifts. She entered multiple items in the fair, winning many 1st place

ribbons. Every year, she would make her famous Pomegranate's Homemade Pomegranate Jelly by the cases.

Kathy's baby though was the Police Activities League (PAL) and especially Jr Giants. She and Jim Ainsworth were instrumental in starting this program in Tehama County in 1995. Kathy served as treasurer for 20 years and has been on

the board for 9 years. Kathy is a huge Giants fan and through Jr Giants met many

players and received the Willy Mac Award (named in Honor of the Hall of Famer

Willy McCovey) for her dedication to the program. Kathy was also inducted into

the Jr Giants Hall of Fame. She would have many fundraisers for PAL, one of her

favorites being the BUNCO Bashes she would put on twice a year.

Kathy is survived by her husband Douglas and son Dylan of Los Molinos, her sisters and brother-in-laws, Brenda and Ron Yancy of Red Bluff, and Cheri and Randy Clayton of Jacksonville, FL, her sister-in-law Donna Jean Nesby of Redding,

her brother-in-law Richard Hausman of Los Molinos, along with many nieces and

nephews. Kathy is preceded in death by her parents, Jesse and Rose Mary Keathley and in-laws Donald and Muriel Hausman.
