



## Leonard Julius Carlson Jr

November 9, 1928 - January 1, 2018

Leonard Julius Carlson Jr., passed away peacefully on New Year's Day 2018 at the age of 89. He was a resident of Corning for the last 30+ years.

Len, as he was called, was born on November 9, 1928 to Salena and Leonard J Carlson Sr. in Jamestown, New York. He married Frances Ann Wisniewski on December 27, 1952 and had two children, Elisa and Robert. He was an officer in the US Army Corps of Engineers, and a veteran of the Korean War, serving two tours. Len was an electrical engineer by training, and he worked in Silicon Valley as it came to be the center of the semiconductor world. After leaving Silicon Valley, Len and Frances built a fine home and olive farm in Corning where Fran still resides. Len was a faithful and active member of the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Corning.

Len was preceded in death by his parents, his brother, John, and his son, Robert Carlson.

In addition to Frances, his loving wife of 65 years, Len is survived by his daughter, Elisa Edwards of Sunnyvale, CA.
