Pat Raymond Hoskins died peacefully, surrounded by his loving family, on Thursday, September 25, following a lengthy, hard-fought battle with cancer. Born on July 29, 1942, to Bob and Elsie Hoskins, in Prescott, Arizona, Pat lived a full and meaningful life. Pat married the love of his life, Melanie, in 1960, and they raised their two children, Nonie and Shannon, on their Taft Street ranch in Los Molinos. Pat had many interests and hobbies; hunting, camping, cruising, and boating were among his favorites. He especially loved spending time with his family and their many friends skiing on the Sacramento River and Shasta and Almanor Lakes. Pat taught his own children and many of their friends how to waterski behind the “green machine”, and he was known to throw quite a roostertail of his own! Pat was the Historian for the Lassen-Loomis Chapter of E. Clampus Vitus, and was proud of his work in helping to select and prepare sites for historical recognition throughout Tehama County. His Clamper brothers will fondly remember his BBQ and grill-master status. Pat was also a member of the Red Bluff Elks Lodge. Pat spent the majority of his work career in the woods as a logger, road builder and heavy equipment operator. He worked most of those years for John Wheeler Logging, and then became self-employed driving his own log truck and then running Pat’s Dozer Service. Pat is survived by his wife of 65 years, Melanie Dyson Hoskins; his daughter Nonie Randles (Ken), and his son, Shannon. He was Papa to four grandchildren; Bobby, Scott, Heather, and Hailey; and six great-grandchildren; Shane, Thomas, Colton, Carley, Presley, and Ali. Pat was

predeceased by his parents, Bob and Elsie Hoskins, and his brother, Mike Hoskins. A graveside service will be held at the Los Molinos Cemetery on Saturday, October 4th at 10:00 a.m. followed by a potluck reception at Pat & Mel's place on Taft Street.
