Willis "Bogy" Ray Henderson passed away peacefully on July 23, 2025, in Corning, California, at the age of 82.

Bogy was born on September 23, 1942, in Red Bluff, California, to the late Willis Henderson and Dolly Peck.

Northern California was his lifelong home, spanning the cities of Red Bluff, Paskenta, Oroville, and Flournoy, before settling in Corning. While young, he also lived briefly in Richmond, Virginia. Bogy had a deep passion for the outdoors, enjoying fishing, hunting, and especially spending time with family in the mountains above Paskenta. He was a joyful dancer and brought a lot of fun to parties, weddings, and events at the Paskenta Hall. Always friendly and loving, he was known for his warm greetings, which often included big hugs and smooches. He was a proud supporter of his local community, including Paskenta Pioneer Days, Corning Jr. Rodeo, and charitable fundraisers. Bogy loved his family and friends fiercely.

Bogy is survived by his children, Todd (Ginny), Tami, Julee (Beth), Troy (Loni);

stepchildren, Rodney (Samantha) and Jon (Angie); Bogy also leaves behind 12 grandchildren and 9 great-grandchildren, as well as many loving relatives and friends. He is preceded in passing by his wife, Sue, son, Rusty, brother, Jim, and sister, CeCe.
